Before entering the classroom I expect that you are...

...ready to learn with a positive attitude.

...on time.

...well-rested and nourished from a healthy breakfast.

...prepared with materials/supplies/homework needed for the day.

When you're in the classroom or field/outside I expect that you will...

...follow directions of adults the first time they are given.

...raise hands and wait for permission before speaking or leaving your seat.

...remain focused and listen to peers and adults.

...participate actively and give your entire attention to the lessons and activities.

...stay in designated areas and boundaries

Classroom Management Expectations

Students will be recognized for their positive behavior. However there will be consequences for disruptive, distracting, or disobedient behavior and will have consequences as follows:

1st Offense -- Verbal Warning

2nd Offense -- Verbal Warning/Write a short reflection

3rd Offense -- Write a Reflection (have signed by a parent/guardian), Email to Parent/Guardian

4th Offense -- Parent Conference

At-Home Expectations

Learning happens in AND out of school. In order to reach the maximum learning potential, students will be expected to complete all homework and virtual assignments (see homework policy). They should have a quiet place and designated time for this without disruptions. I strongly recommend students and parents regularly consult Google Classroom and the student planner to understand the student's assignments. Also, both parents/guardians and students should regularly check PowerSchool as to be aware of the student's grades.

Grading System

- 50% Assessments
- 25% Homework
- 20% 21st Century Skills
- 5% Conduct

Homework/Classwork/Field Work/Virtual Work

Homework will be given throughout the week. It will be discussed in class and posted on Google Classroom. Homework will be due by the date given in class and posted on Google Classroom.

Classwork/Field Work assignments will be given. This is to be completed during class or in the field. Students will be given a grade for completion of classwork or field work.

Virtual work will be assigned and should be treated as school work and must be completed by the assigned deadline.

Absent

If you are absent, you are responsible for checking Google Classroom for homework, classwork, assessment or other important information. If you missed a test or quiz, you must make arrangements to make-up the test or quiz. It is the student’s responsibility to make up missing work. Students will have a one school day for each day absent. For example, if you missed two days of school, you will have two days to make up any assignments.

Please let your teacher know if you are going to be absent by sending an email (preferred) or by phone.

Late Work Policy

Any assignment or project that is turned in passed the due date will be accepted by the teacher upon their approval. There may be a deduction of points from the assignment or project total for lateness.
